Adjusted EBITDA is defined as EBITDA adjusted for gain on asset divestitures, pre-tax, net loss attributable to non-controlling interests, stock-based compensation expenses, pre-tax, one-time employee restructuring expenses, pre-tax, litigation costs and settlements, pre-tax, transaction related expenses, pre-tax, other non-cash revenue & expenses, pre-tax, and certain other adjustments as defined from time to

Adjusted Net Income:

Adjusted Net Income, is defined as net income attributable to GEO adjusted for certain items which by their nature are not comparable from period to period or that tend to obscure GEO's actual operating performance, including for the periods presented gain on asset divestitures, pre-tax, loss on extinguishment of debt, pre-tax, one-time employee restructuring expenses, litigation costs and settlements pre-tax, transaction related expenses, pre-tax, and the tax effect of adjustments to net income attributable to GEO.

Net Debt/Net Leverage:

Net Debt is defined as gross principal debt less cash from restricted subsidiaries. Net Leverage is defined as Net Debt divided by Adjusted EBITDA.

Net Operating Income (NOI):

Net Operating Income is defined as revenues less operating expenses, excluding depreciation and amortization expense, general and administrative expenses, real estate related operating lease expense, and gain on asset divestitures, pre-tax. Net Operating Income is calculated as net income adjusted by subtracting equity in earnings of affiliates, net of income tax provision, and by adding income tax provision, interest expense, net of interest income, loss on extinguishment of debt, depreciation and amortization expense, general and administrative expenses, operating lease expense, real estate, and gain on asset divestitures, pre-tax.
